

# HUNTER REGION SUMMER SERIES – ROUND 1

## EVENT PROTOCOL

### LONG JUMP

- Wherever possible officials will endeavour to have a maximum of 10 athletes awaiting their trials with social distancing between athletes.
- Once athletes have completed their trials they are to leave the competition area to allow further athletes to assemble for their trials.
- Assembly area will be between the long jump runway and the wheelchair lane of the track. No athletes while awaiting trials is to congregate near the boundary fence.
- Wherever possible Officials will only complete one task while officiating at the events.
- If there is a change of official's duties all equipment in use will be sanitised before new official commences their task including administrative item (clipboard etc.)
- All officials are asked to provide their own pens, no sharing of pens.

### SHOT PUT/JAVELIN

- Wherever possible officials will endeavour to have a maximum of 10 athletes awaiting their trials with social distancing between.
- The athletes three trials will be concurrent.
- Once athletes have completed their trial's they are to leave the competition area to allow further athletes to assemble for their trials.
- Athletes are not to handle the implements before their trials.
- Officials are to wear gloves provided while handling the implements.
- Implements used are to be sanitised (antibacterial wiped/alcohol-based sanitiser) following completion of the three trials.
- Wherever possible Officials will only complete one task while officiating at the events.
- If there is a change of official's duties all equipment in use will be sanitised before new official commences their task including administrative item (clipboard etc')
- All officials are asked to provide their own pens, no sharing of pens.

### TRACK EVENTS

- Ground announcer will only call competitors to the assembly area once sufficient room is available for the next event.
- Athletes are not to proceed to the track assembly area until asked, by the ground announcer to do so.
- Athletes are requested to take minimal gear to the track assembly area to allow more space for competitors.
- Athletes are requested to leave the finish line as quickly as possible while bearing in mind social distancing restriction.
- Athletes are asked to be aware of the numbers at the start assembly area when collecting their gear following the event.
- Wherever possible only one starter will use for a particular event.
- If there is a change of starter all starting equipment handled is to be sanitised before new starter commences their duty.
